Confidentiality	
I have been informed that mediation is a confidential process. Under Ne	w Vork State law communications made during
mediation provided by this center may not be introduced in court by the mediators or the parties, except in very limited	
circumstances-outlined below. All statements, memoranda, work products, notes, and the center's case files are	
confidential and are not admissible in court.	,,
<b>Exceptions to Confidentiality</b>	
<b>Child Abuse:</b> I understand that evidence of child abuse is not confidential and may be reported by the center to the appropriate authorities.	
<b>Agreements:</b> I understand that each party is free to enter into either a ve	erhal or written agreement, as well as to reject
any potential agreement. If we decide to create a written document that reflects the terms of our agreement, I also	
understand and agree that this written agreement is not confidential (If it is a Family Court Agreement) and any party	
may submit the document as evidence of our agreement in court. I understand that the agreement might be legally	
binding on us if a judge concludes that it is enforceable.	
Court- Referred Cases: I understand that the courts may refer cases to the Dispute Resolution Center of Delaware,	
Otsego and Schoharie Counties and I agree that the center may provide the following information to a court that referred	
my case to mediation:	
• If a mediation was held and if so, the date that this mediation occurred.	
• The parties' request, if any, for additional time to mediate.	
• The outcome of the mediation session, including a copy of the particle	ipants' family court agreement, if one is reached.
